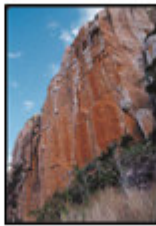


# Eco Catchment Tours – Mt. Stuart »



## MT. STUART

Mt Stuart is well worth the visit. On the 25 minute drive to the top look out for grass trees, butterflies, rock wallabies and the occasional peacock. Also noticeable are the different colours and textures of the rocks and grasses. From the main viewing platform at the top there are panoramic views of Townsville City and the surrounding savannah lands, Magnetic Island and the Great Barrier Reef world heritage area. Take time to do the short 20 minute walk around the summit with interpretative signage and spectacular views.

**An important landmark to residents and visitors the area is of great environmental importance and is home to many native plants and animals.**

### Flora

Mt Stuart Gum - *Eucalyptus paedoglauca*. Endemic to the Mt Stuart area

White Mahogany – *Eucalyptus acmenoides*

Pink Bloodwood – *Corymbia intermedia*

Grass Tree - *Xanthorrhoea johnsonii*



### Fauna

Allied Rock Wallaby – *Petrogale assimilis*



Echidna – *Tachyglossus aculeatus*
